1) Registration

Registration is now open **until November 25th** and all orders must be completed and paid through [Silvensa website](#) **BEFORE December 5th**.

Remember: after this date we cannot guarantee the number of spots available in the various activities, and thus you may not be able to book the events you are interested in!! **So for your own comfort please book as soon as possible!**

Registration fee costs **only €10** and we offer **lots of activities to choose from** so don't forget to tell your friends!

2) How to go to Silvensa in Marseille

After registration you will need to book your travel quickly, you can go there:

By plane: we recommend to use price comparison websites like www.skyscanner.com or www.Misterfly.be as those websites are used by travel agencies and professionals.

The closest airports are **Aéroport Marseille Provence (MRS)** and the low cost **Aéroport Marseille Provence Terminal 2 (MP2)**: <https://www.marseille-airport.com/>

By train: If you want to go to Marseille using the bullet train (aka TGV in French) you can already buy your tickets, since the booking has just opened!! You can for example book your seat directly with the [SNCF](http://www.sncf.com) (french railway company), through the website you usually use or by checking a price comparison websites like <https://www.omio.com/>

The closest train station is Marseille Saint-Charles.

By bus: go to [Flixbus](http://www.flixbus.com) or [Eurolines](http://www.eurolines.com) and select Marseille Saint-Charles as your destination, the buses arrive at the bus station not far from Marseille Saint-Charles train station.

By car: If you want to use your car, please remember that the traffic is usually bad and there are lots of traffic jams. Also parking lots are not cheap in Marseilles, but they can be booked in advance (in case your hotel does not provide such service) using one of those websites: [OPnGo](http://www.opngo.com) or [Q-Park](http://www.q-park.com).

**Don't be tardy to book your transport, the prices are going up very quickly!
